

Content Creator Contract

This **Content Creator Contract** ("**Agreement**") is entered into as of _____ ("**Effective Date**"), by and between:

Company

Creator

Company and Creator may be referred to individually as a "**Party**" and collectively as the "**Parties.**"

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to set out the terms under which the Creator will produce and deliver content for the Company, and the Company will compensate the Creator for such services.

2. Scope of Services

The Creator agrees to create and deliver content as described below:

Content Type	Description	Platform	Quantity	Delivery Deadline

The Creator shall:

- Produce original content in accordance with the Company's brand guidelines and instructions
- Ensure timely delivery of all agreed content
- Make reasonable revisions if requested by the Company, provided such requests are within the original scope

3. Term

This Agreement shall commence on the Effective Date and continue until _____ or until completion of the services, unless terminated earlier in accordance with the Termination clause.

4. Compensation

The Company shall compensate the Creator as follows:

Payment Type	Amount	Payment Terms

Payment shall be made within _____ days of receipt of a valid invoice, unless otherwise agreed.

The Creator is responsible for all applicable taxes and expenses unless expressly stated otherwise.

5. Content Standards and Compliance

The Creator agrees that all content shall:

- Be original and not infringe any third-party rights
- Comply with applicable advertising, marketing, and disclosure requirements
- Avoid unlawful, misleading, or offensive material
- Accurately represent any products or services featured

Where required, the Creator shall include appropriate disclosures indicating sponsored or paid content.

6. Intellectual Property Rights

Unless otherwise agreed in writing:

- Upon full payment, the Company shall have a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive license to use, reproduce, distribute, and display the content for business and marketing purposes.
- The Creator retains ownership of the original content, including underlying creative elements.

The Creator grants the Company the right to edit, adapt, and repurpose the content, provided such use does not materially misrepresent the Creator.

7. Confidentiality

The Creator shall keep confidential any non-public information received from the Company and shall not disclose such information to any third party without prior written consent.

This obligation continues after the termination of this Agreement.

8. Representations and Warranties

The Creator represents and warrants that:

- The content is original and does not violate any intellectual property or other rights
- The Creator has the full authority to enter into this Agreement
- The content will meet the agreed specifications and quality standards

The Company represents that it has the right to engage the Creator and use the content as outlined in this Agreement.

9. Independent Contractor Relationship

The Creator is engaged as an independent contractor. Nothing in this Agreement shall be interpreted as creating an employment, partnership, or agency relationship.

The Creator is solely responsible for:

- Their own taxes and insurance
- Any assistants or subcontractors used to perform the services

10. Termination

Either Party may terminate this Agreement:

- For convenience, by providing _____ days' written notice to the other Party
- For cause, if the other Party materially breaches this Agreement and fails to remedy such breach within a reasonable period after receiving written notice

Upon termination:

- The Creator shall cease work and deliver any completed or partially completed content
- The Company shall pay for all approved work completed up to the termination date
- Any rights granted prior to termination remain in effect unless otherwise agreed

11. Limitation of Liability

To the extent permitted by applicable law, neither Party shall be liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages arising from this Agreement.

Each Party's total liability under this Agreement shall not exceed the total amount paid or payable under this Agreement.

12. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution

This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of _____.

Any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement shall first be addressed through good faith negotiations between the Parties. If unresolved, the dispute shall be submitted to a competent court in the applicable jurisdiction.

13. Amendments

This Agreement may only be amended or modified by a written document signed by both Parties.

14. Entire Agreement

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties regarding its subject matter and supersedes all prior discussions or agreements.

15. Notices

All notices under this Agreement shall be in writing and delivered to the addresses of the Parties stated above or to any updated address notified in writing.

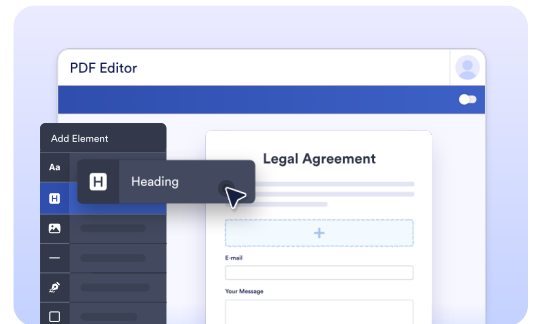

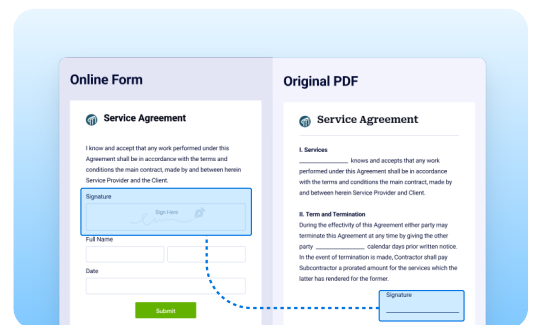

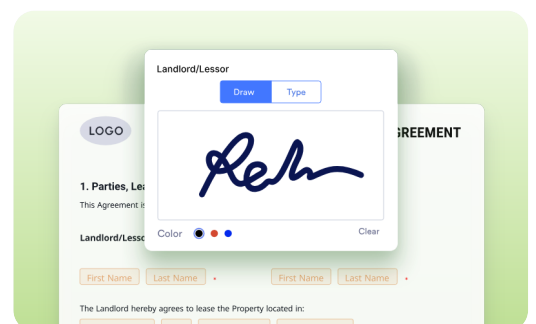
