Pet Adoption Contract

Terms of this Agreement

1- _____, hereinafter referred to as the pet, is being transferred to the adopting owner with the understanding that the adopter is taking possession of the pet to treat and to be responsible for it as their own pet.

2- The Adopter agrees to pay the Adoption Donation in the amount of _____ to help defray the Owner's expenses for food, sheltering, spaying or neutering, vaccinations and veterinary care. Additional donations are welcome. I understand that all donations are NON-REFUNDABLE.

3- The pet will be treated as a family member with loving care and affection. I will do my best to ensure the pet's safety and well-being.

4- I agree to immediately contact the Owner if I move and change address to ensure that all records and microchip information is updated.

5- I agree to keep an identification attached to a properly fitted collar, on the pet at all times. I agree to obtain, and maintain the proper license if required under local law. I also agree to comply with all local and state laws that apply to pets.

6- I agree to provide the pet with necessary vaccinations as advised by the Pet's veterinarian. I also agree to obtain immediate veterinary care should the Pet become sick or injured and to take full responsibility for any veterinary expenses. Owner is not responsible for any veterinary expenses.

7- I agree to treat the Pet as an indoor pet and household companion, not as an outdoor pet. This means that the Pet must be kept inside the home in a safe place at all times. The Pet cannot be left outside while unsupervised unless the Owner has given prior written approval.

8- I agree to provide the Pet with humane treatment at all times. This means providing the Pet with proper food, fresh water, proper shelter and exercise, and allowing a reasonable amount of time for the Pet to adjust to new surroundings.

9- I agree not to have the dog attack-trained nor shall I use it for any purpose other than companionship. I will not have the dog's ears cropped nor will I have its tail docked. I will never allow any physical, mental, or emotional abuse of the dog.

10- I understand that there is no guarantee of any kind as to the health, temperament, training or age of the Pet. I understand that the Owner, its agents and employees make no representation or guarantee of any kind, either explicitly or implicitly, as to the health, temperamental, mental disposition or training of the Pet.

11- If the Pet shall for any reason, be picked up by local law enforcement or animal control;

- The Owner must immediately be notified,
- The authorities must be notified,
- Euthanasia of the Pet shall never be allowed,
- The Adopter may be responsible for refunding the Owner for the costs of recovering the Pet.

12- If the Pet is wished to be returned and the Adopter is unwilling or unable to care for the Pet for its entire life, the Adopter must contact the Owner and arrange for the return of the Pet to a location specified by the Owner. The Pet cannot be returned without the prior written approval of the Owner. The Adopter is responsible for the proper care of the Pet until the Pet has been delivered to the Owner, and agrees to take all necessary steps to ensure the safe return of the Pet to Owner.

13- The Adopter agrees and accepts that the adoption donation is NON-REFUNDABLE. Adopter agrees that in the event that the Pet is returned more than 30 days after the signing of this Pet Adoption Agreement, then Adopter will pay a surrender donation of \$250 to the Owner.

14- The Adopter is not permitted under any circumstances to transfer permanent custody, ownership or possession of the Pet to anyone, including family or friends or any entity or agency, without the Owner's prior written approval.

15- If the Adopter fails to comply with this Agreement, the Owner has the right to reclaim the Pet with the procedure as follows:

- In the event that the Pet's life is in immediate danger, the Owner may seek any means necessary to recover the Pet, with or without the Adopter's notice or approval, and the Adopter must reimburse the Owner for any expenses in the safe recovery of the Pet.

- In the event that the Pet's life is not in immediate danger, the Owner will send a reclamation notice to the Adopter. The Adopter must respond to the reclamation notice within 5 days of receipt. If the Adopter fails to return the Pet or fails to timely respond to the reclamation notice, the Owner may take appropriate legal action to retrieve the Pet, and the Adopter must reimburse the Owner for any expenses in the safe recovery of the Pet.

- The Adopter has 5 days following the reclamation of the Pet to discuss the matter with the Owner. Any decision as to whether the Pet will be returned back to the Adopter is in the sole discretion of the Owner.

16- Release of Liability: The Adopter, and for his/her spouse, heirs, executors, personal representatives and assigns, agrees never to bring a claim or suit against PW. The Adopter releases the Owner and its directors, founders, employees, officers, agents, representatives, contractors, volunteers, successors and assigns from all liability arising from the adoption or behavior or actions of the Pet. The Adopter understands that this agreement discharges the Owner and its directors, founders, employees, officers, agents, representatives, contractors, volunteers, successors and assigns from any liability to the Adopter and his/her spouse, heirs, executors and assigns, with

respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, amputation, scarring, death, property damage or other loss that may result from the adoption or behavior or activities of the Pet. The Adopter releases the Owner and discharges the Owner and its directors, founders, employees, officers, agents, representatives, contractors, volunteers, successors and assigns from any liability for Owner's own negligence or liability that may result in bodily injury, personal injury, illness, amputation, scarring, death, property damage or other loss to the Adopter.

17- Indemnity Agreement: The Adopter, and for his/her spouse, heirs, executors, personal representatives, and assigns, agrees to indemnify and hold the Owner harmless for all bodily injury, personal injury, illness, amputation, scarring, death, property damage or other losses, including attorney's fees and costs of litigation, that result to anyone else or any other entity because of the Adopter's negligence or liability. This includes lone acts or omissions by the Adopter as well as the combined acts of the Adopter with others.

I, THE ADOPTER, AGREE THAT I AM LEGALLY COMPETENT TO ENTER INTO THIS AGREEMENT, I AM THE ONLY HOUSEHOLD DECISION MAKER REGARDING PET ADOPTION, AND THIS AGREEMENT IS BINDING UPON THE HEIRS, ASSIGNS, SUCCESSORS, PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVES AND EXECUTORS OF BOTH PARTIES.

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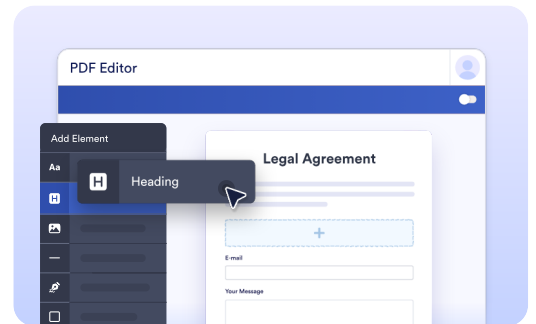
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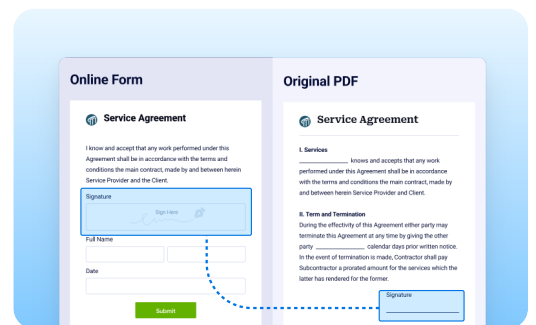
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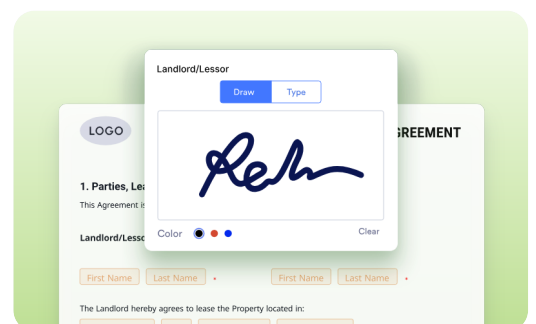
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
